



INTERVIEW

MICHAEL GROENEWALD Editor of THE MAN ON THE MOON

What makes Man on the Moon special for you, as an editor?

Man on the Moon occupies an unusual place in German comics due to its seemingly effortless combination of profundity and entertainment. At the heart of the story is the tension between familial responsibility and self-realization that Uli Oesterle explores precisely, unsparingly, and yet sensitively – for all concerned – over two generations. Despite serious subjects such as alcoholism, illness, and homelessness, he succeeds in creating a vibrant, entertaining, and often hilarious comic narrative. It's great fun to read, but even in its most piercing moments, it never fails to respect the fundamental injuries and the often-tragic fate of its characters.

4 keywords that describe the story?

Ambivalent characters, apt and polyphonic dialogue, inventive yet pointed storytelling, elegant drawings.

What images, which part of the story do you find unforgettable?

I was particularly impressed by those passages in which the formerly egocentric protagonist Rufus Himmelstoss slips into homelessness. Against the backdrop of 1970s Munich, among whose must-see sights Rufus had recently counted himself, we watch the agonizingly slow character change of a self-absorbed puke into someone who, stripped of his glittery trappings, develops something akin to true dignity.





Intriguing concept: who's the heroic figure and who's the monster?


Was Medusa a monster? Was Perseus a hero? Not in this comic by André Breinbauer. **The story turns the wellknown myth upside down** and tells it from the perspective of both figures in a radically different way: Medusa is not the monster who, out of malice, turns people into stone. Abused by a god and punished by a goddess, she is twice-victimized by the deities. Perseus, on the other hand, is still a child and a plaything of the mighty.

There are **two unique aspects to this graphic novel:** the first is that **it is read from both sides, from Medusa's and from Perseus'**; the other is a **feminist view** of the myth that completely **differentiates it from other Medusa interpretations.**

André Breinbauer studied graphic design at the Academy of Fine Arts Nuremberg. Since 2005, he has lived in Vienna as a freelance illustrator and comics artist. When he was a child, the television series *Traveling with Odysseus* fascinated him and quickened a lifelong interest in Greek mythology, an interest palpable on every page of *Medusa and Perseus*. With this title, he was a finalist in the 2021 comic-book prize awarded by the Berthold Leibinger Foundation.






