


















Dear Publishers,



INTERVIEW WITH THE AUTHOR BRITTA SABBAG

There are several picture books that deal with the subject of children's feelings. What's different about the picture book series with your texts and the terrific pictures by Igor Lange?


Emotions are often viewed very seriously – I wanted books that were lighter, more humorous. That's especially useful when the situation is tense. Because laughing always helps, doesn't it?

What was there first – the feelings you wanted to talk about or the animals with which certain qualities are associated? And is there an animal you can identify with?

The elephant in the first book was inspired by my son, who's really stubborn – I guess he got that from me;-). The panther isn't a particularly relaxed animal per se, so that's why he first had to learn that. And an emotional polar bear, which is in fact dangerous but at the same time needs a hug, is a creature we can all understand. There are many times we also wrestle with conflicting emotions, and I really wanted to show that.

Can you tell us more about the third volume, where the main character is a little polar bear?

The polar bear is very emotional and doesn't yet know how to deal with these feelings. At the beginning he thinks he reacts "too much" or "too strongly," and that that's not a desirable characteristic, so he feels bad about himself. But gradually he catches on that the other animals are perfectly okay with this. And he feels better about himself – doesn't perceive his emotions as a burden anymore, but rather part of his personality. It was immensely important to me to get this across to children.





Ava comes from Afghanistan and lives in a refugee shelter. Everything here is unfamiliar to her, and the situation is overwhelming. It's good that she has her loving father and her stuffed animal, and that she is and remains the one-and-only Ava.

We thank Saša Stanišić and Regina Kehn for this masterpiece. The story helps children understand what a refugee child might experience, teaches empathy, and provides opportunities for discussion. During a storm, Father Squirrel is thrown from the nest. Two children find him completely exhausted in the park and nurse him a little too "lovingly" back to health: He is blowdried, dressed, fed with nut-nougat cream, and wheeled around in a doll's baby carriage.

But while walking in the park, the two children find out that he has a family that misses him, and they realize that Father Squirrel won't really be happy with eating nut-nougat cream and wearing a doll's outfit. Now they're going to risk their necks in an attempt (which ends happily!) to reunite the family.

A picture book all about the question, "If you could wish for anything..."
Even the author doesn't really know what he should write down. Nothing seems to work. What can the reader expect to find? A prose poem, unrhymed, hilarious, and an Andreas Steinhöfel-Nadia Budde book that couldn't be any better!

Head of the brand editorial department at Carlsen

Frank, what makes the concept special and who is the target audience for MangaStories?

Our new MangaStories are for all kids 9-10 and up who have heard of or seen manga illustrations and like them, and who are curious about manga. Naturally, we aren't targeting the 14-year-old manga nerds. More the new, young manga fans, as well as all parents looking to buy their children books that match kids' trends. The books are written so that they're extra-short on text, extra-long on manga pictures, and extra-exciting and action-packed.

Can you tell us about upcoming segments of the Carlsen MangaStories program?

In Fall 2024 the program continues with our third new MangaStories series, School of Beastly Island. Our heroes land in a school on an island where big and small, funny and dangerous monsters are roaming around.

Very exciting for girls and boys 10 and up.





Claudia, you are one of the authors of this new series. What was the challenge for you in writing – did you have to think of the story in pictures, or how did the text-to-picture ratio in the novels develop?

I write the picture scenarios and speech bubbles. The editor sends my suggestions to the wonderful artist Clara d'Amico, who normally accepts them, sometimes with variations. Actually, I always have that "film in my head" with whatever kind of book I write. The challenge with a manga novel is the double-page layout structure:

I have to construct each scene so that the finished double page looks good – and there are lots of different actions that have to take place so that the pictures aren't always the same.

Mangas are a mega-trend all over the world and still gaining in popularity. Who exactly is the target audience for CAT GIRLS?



INTERVIEW WITH THE AUTHORS OF THE SERIES

There will be four volumes within this series, covering the subjects of thinking, feeling, love and death. Subjects which, in a sense, determine our everyday lives. What facts and insights can one take away from the We Live series, and how are your books new and different compared to other books on these subjects?

Well, it's precisely this notion of their being self-evident that sometimes makes us think we don't really need to say a lot about these "big" themes of life – just to assume it's somehow all obvious and pretty much the same for everyone. But if we take a closer look, it's not that way at all, and we all experience differences, which can be depressing but also tremendously exciting and enriching. Our books are invitations to explore those possibilities, and the fact that they do it so comprehensively and equally for all four of these major topics is perhaps really something special.

Why are books about thinking, feeling, death and love interesting for grade-schoolers?

Because it's often what determines children's everyday lives much more than we adults think - these "big" questions really do exist, and they need space. Only then do children get the chance to express themselves and not be left alone with these questions. We adults have these questions too, of course, but often push them aside. Children still have so much to discover, and at the same time they already have so much to talk about, have their own thoughts, and are often better at talking about their feelings than we are - that's why it's also about having conversations and looking for answers that are important not only for children.

You're one of our most experienced authors, whose works sell very well in Germany as well as in other countries. What makes your books so successful?

Honestly, I don't think anybody really knows. I only know how a book has to feel for me before I'm satisfied with it: kids should enjoy it – and since I'm a big kid myself, I should enjoy it too. After all, reading is great!

On a scale from 1 to 10, where do you see your ESCAPE CHALLENGE books when it comes to promoting reading?

Ha – hard question with that scale! I myself learned to read very late and had issues with dyslexia for quite a long time. So I remember all too well how it feels to look at the thickness of a book. How difficult it is to have to tackle another page.

With the Escape Challenge books, the next page is a reward. So there's a steady feeling of accomplishment. That's a sure-fire way to encourage page-turning.

Even kids in elementary school are confronted with the question of Get out the smartphone or open a book?! How can you get kids to choose the book?

There are readers who simply read. Something goes CLICK and they just can't stop. These kinds of kids are pure joy for us book people, of course. But what if things don't just fall into place like that? My three tips are: read to them, read to them, and read to them. Even long after the point when they can read by themselves. In addition, I'd also try offering them different sorts of texts.

At least that's what the parents who send me thank-you letters have done, and they enclose pictures of their children lying on the sofa and doing something highly unusual: reading!
