With Hats, KAREN EXNER is publishing her first (and hopefully not last) picture book with Carlsen.

Kids and hats – those are two things that aren't necessarily thought of together. How did you get the idea to write a children's book about hats?

I'm curious about the aspect of identity that clothes lend, how they influence our perception of roles. I find national or regional folk costumes particularly interesting. I wanted to pair this interest with my passion for picture-book artwork. Headwear is often the most distinctive aspect of clothing. It's very diverse, fun to draw, and looks awesome. All those things make headwear a visual hook to get to know various people and cultures. And I believe that's interesting for both kids and grownups.

Do you have a favorite type of hat or head covering?

The top hat, which, due to its iconic form, is also on the book's cover. At one time, members of Parliament in the British House of Commons were required to put on a top hat whenever they wanted to speak. Wearing this hat just makes you feel more "present"! That's why I always wear one at my readings.


Dealing with so many hats in their cultural contexts must certainly offer lots of opportunities to learn something new. What was the most interesting thing you learned while doing research for your book?

How many connections can be made between headwear and different cultures and eras. I tried to emphasize those connections in double-paged layouts. For example, the chef's hat, or toque, and the feathered headdress are together on a double page: the number of folds in the toque used to symbolize how many recipes the chef knew; the number of feathers in the headdress stood for how many courageous deeds the wearer had shown in battle.

What made you decide to write about fear in your first book for children?

The idea wormed its way in while I was writing, so in a sense, it was part of the journey. Just like fear – which can suddenly overtake you or slowly sneak up on you. Besides, fear is something that everyone is familiar with – whether they're big or small, alone or with someone else. Although of course, it's always better to be with someone else – the two protagonists of this story know that, too.


It's impressive how close your narrative tone and portrayal of emotional experience are to the target group. Is that because you vividly remember your own childhood, or how is it that you're able to depict the world of your protagonists so authentically?

I find that kids/adolescents are usually cooler people than grown-ups. They have interesting thoughts and good ideas, and I don't believe that I, as an adult, have any particular advantage over them in a lot of especially relevant matters. This attitude surely helps in being able to slip back into my old familiar perspective on things. Besides that, I've been surrounded by children my whole life – either because they're related to me or because I've shared my living space and everyday life with them. I really enjoy being around kids. Just in general. And in my books.


Your book Stumbling Through was a well-received coming-of-age novel. Now you've followed up with your first children's book. Can you tell us which age group it was more fun to write for?

I don't consider myself to be writing for one strictly defined age group. But so far, writing from the perspective of a particular age group (namely, the ones who are still growing) has been the most fun for me, and that's why I'd like to continue doing it. Why Vienna, of all places, and not Paris?

Vienna has this very special, royal-glamorous touch. I wanted to have Livia's story take place in a high society that's characterized, above all, by tradition and an old-money lifestyle: Horse-drawn carriages clattering through cobblestone streets, the balls, the ornate facades, and the ubiquitous presence of Empress Sissi offered me the perfect setting to convey this vibe. And when you stroll through the streets of Vienna, marveling at these intricate facades on the buildings, it's very easy to imagine that there are also dark abysses behind all the glitter. This is the discrepancy that's depicted in VIENNA.

What makes VIENNA so special, a book that you just can't put down?

I think the special thing about VIENNA is the snappy, quick-witted dialogue, which gives the book a certain lightness despite the tragic characters and the pain of the protagonist. And there are many interesting locations and events that give the readers entrance into a world of glitter, glamour, and shameful darkness. The love story between Livia and Nicolas is sustained above all by their clashes and the gripping enemies-to-lovers vibes.

When you don't happen to be writing or working with kids as a psychotherapist, what do you like to read, and do you have a favorite author?

If you take a look at my bookshelf, you'll find that I don't follow one particular direction or genre. I read all kinds of things: romance, thrillers, fantasy, and sometimes contemporary literature. I'm quite taken with Taylor Jenkins Reid.
