This work fills a significant gap in graphic literature by addressing women's health issues with both scientific accuracy and emotional authenticity.



Rinah Lang studied illustration in the Netherlands and Scotland and lived in Paris for a while before moving to Berlin, where she now lives with her family. *Peri Meno* is her first graphic novel, in which she explores menopause and aging in an autobiographical and investigative way.





Parallel to Fritz Honka and his milieu unfolds the story of the wealthy shipowner's family Dohren. At first glance two very different worlds, which are nevertheless connected by desolation. In the end these two worlds meet in "The Golden Glove" pub.



Heinz Strunk is a writer, musician, and actor. Strunk is well known for his bestseller *Fleisch ist mein Gemüse* (Meat is my Veg).



In 1972, young Ahmadjan Amani travels from Afghanistan to Germany. He wants to be an artist, and almost ten years later he becomes the father of the author.


